  - 5.1. **PCSO Report** – No item received.
  - 5.2. **Hosepipe Ban** – Anglian Water will bring this ban into effect from Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> April 2012.
  - 5.3. **Dudgeon Offshore Wind Ltd** – Are appealing to The Planning Inspectorate against the refusal for planning permission by NNDC for; *Installation of buried electrical cable system in connection with off-shore wind farm site at route between Weybourne Hope (TG104,436) and Little Dunham (TF868,118).*
6. **PLANNING** – Application no. PO/12/0224 – *Proposal; Erection of seven garages with four apartments above at, **1 Dereham Road, Pudding Norton.** It was *proposed & agreed* “to support this application in principle for the following reasons. i) Government Policy is to encourage development on 'Brownfield Sites' rather than 'Greenfield Sites', subject to appropriate conditions. ii) Such development would enhance and improve the entrance into the village. iii) This site lies opposite the main entrance to Fakenham Racecourse and the development would be a much better welcome to one of the Counties top attractions. iv) To our knowledge there has been no local opposition to this development.”*
